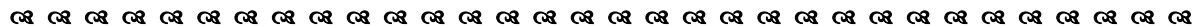
- **Spaghetti Sauce Jars** - 3-cup size jars for mincemeat (Ragu type). Thank you!

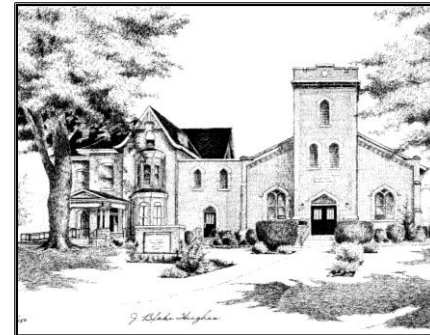
OUR PURPOSE
