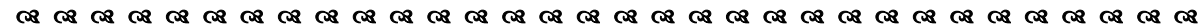
Tai Chi – we will be meeting again every Friday morning at 10:30 a.m. starting September 21st. All welcome!

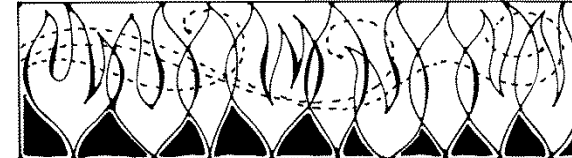
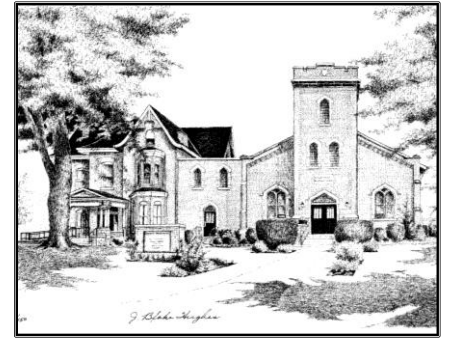
